Arts Academy Class Descriptions

<u>KiddyKeys®</u> teaches keyboard concepts, general music concepts, and music appreciation in energetic, fun and memorable ways, including books, games, manipulatives, and songs with motion. Students play the keyboard and rhythm instruments several times in each class and progress through keyboard basics, such as note values, key names, hand position, and finger numbers. Enrollment open to students age 3-6; check website for specific age breakdowns. Class meets once a week for 45 minutes (immediately following Weekday Education during the school year); limit 6 students per class; tuition \$40/month.

<u>Tykes & Tunes</u> (<u>Music & Development</u>) encourages young children to explore music and movement while developing coordination, fine and gross motor skills, and social interactions. Accompanied by a parent (grandparent, nanny, or other adult), children engage in fun songs with motions, fingerplays, dance, musical games and stories, and more. *Enrollment open to students age 1 month to 3 years. Students must be accompanied by a participating adult.* Class meets once a week for 1 hour, including 30 minutes of instruction and 30 minutes of supervised social interaction and play. Tuition is \$40 per month (pre-registration required); drop-in classes available for \$15/class.

<u>FunHarmonics</u> (<u>Instrument Experience</u>) introduces children of all ages to the various band, orchestral, and other instruments. Each week, students interact with a particular instrument – listening, touching, even playing! This class is a great opportunity to educate children (and parents) trying to decide which instrument to play. <u>Enrollment open to all ages, perfect for homeschool families</u>. <u>Students under 5 must be accompanied by an adult</u>. <u>Class meets once a week for 30 minutes</u>. <u>Tuition is \$40 per month (pre-registration required); drop-in classes available for \$15/class</u>.

<u>Imagine That</u> (Moral Drama and Musical Theatre) invites students to engage their imaginations in morality-based creative movement games and stories, drama exercises, and on-stage experiences. Students learn stage terms, performance techniques, and actor/audience etiquette. Students also develop public speaking skills and stage presence through famous quotes, poetry, and tongue twisters. In-class performance opportunities are offered at the end of the semester. Enrollment available to students ages 3-14; check website for specific age breakdowns. Class meets once a week for 1 hour. Tuition is \$40 per month. (Registration is required; no drop-in classes available.)

<u>Music Theory Level 1</u> introduces basic music including: the staff, treble and bass clef, sharps and flats, major scales, key signatures, note values and nomenclature, dynamics, music terms and sings, music notation, and more. *Enrollment open to students 12 years and older. No previous music theory or piano instruction required.* All classes are conducted online. Tuition is \$100; full payment is required.

<u>Music Theory Level 2</u> continues with advanced music theory, including: intervals, circle of fifths, order of sharps and flats, additional major and minor scales, transposition, time signatures, triplets, syncopation, and more. *Enrollment open to students 12 years and older. Some previous music theory or minimum 2 years piano instruction required. All classes are conducted online. Tuition is* \$100; full payment is required.
