Facts about prayer. Luke 11:1

- We are all <u>wired</u> for prayer. Luke 11:1; Eccl. 3:11; Luke 18:9-14; Matt. 6:5-8
- We are not very <u>good</u> at prayer. Luke 11:1; Rom. 8:26; Matt. 26:40-41
- We get <u>frustrated</u> with prayer because of a lack of understanding. Luke 11:1
 - Prayer is not a magic wand.
 - Prayer is not 911 praying.
 - Prayer is having to **fight** God.
 - Prayer is not a <u>ritual</u> but a relationship and conversation with God.

Foundational truth about prayer (God's love). Luke 11:1; Matt. 6:5-8; 1 John 4:8

- Love that wants to <u>hear</u> from us. Ps. 103:13; 1 John 14:14-15; John 14:13; Jer. 29:11-12; 1 Thess. 5:17
- Love that listens to a <u>heart</u> that is sincere and simple. Matt. 6:5-8; Heb. 10:22; Luke 18:9-14; Ps. 62:8; 42:4; Lam 2:19
- Love that shows His <u>grace</u> by answering our prayer.
 Jer. 33:3; Matt. 7:11; James 4:2; 1 Thess. 5:17;
 John 16:24; Matt. 21:22
- Love that longs to be <u>close</u> to us. Is. 30:18; John 15:15; Ps. 25:14; James 4:8
